DE-MARTINO HOSPITAL PROFILE



- ❖ Demartino Public Hospital is a public healthcare institution that has been serving the Somali people for over a century.
- ❖ It was founded in **1922** by the Italian colonial administration and named after General Cesare Maria De Vecchi di Val Cismon, who was also known as De Martino.
- ❖ The hospital is located in Mogadishu, the capital city of Somalia, and is the oldest and largest public hospital in the country.
- ❖ The hospital has a capacity of more than **280** beds and employs a wide range of staff, including doctors, nurses, laboratories, anesthesiologists, hygienists, cleaners, porters, guides, IT, HR logistics, and others.
- ❖ The hospital is managed by the Minister of Health (**FMOH**)
- ❖ The hospital offers a wide range of health services to more than **550** patients every morning, including children, women (pregnant or not pregnant), and adults who become hospitalized or outpatient.
- ❖ The hospital has various departments, such as general medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, general surgery, laboratory, pharmacy, diagnostic imaging, IPD ward, clinic, emergency department and ICU.

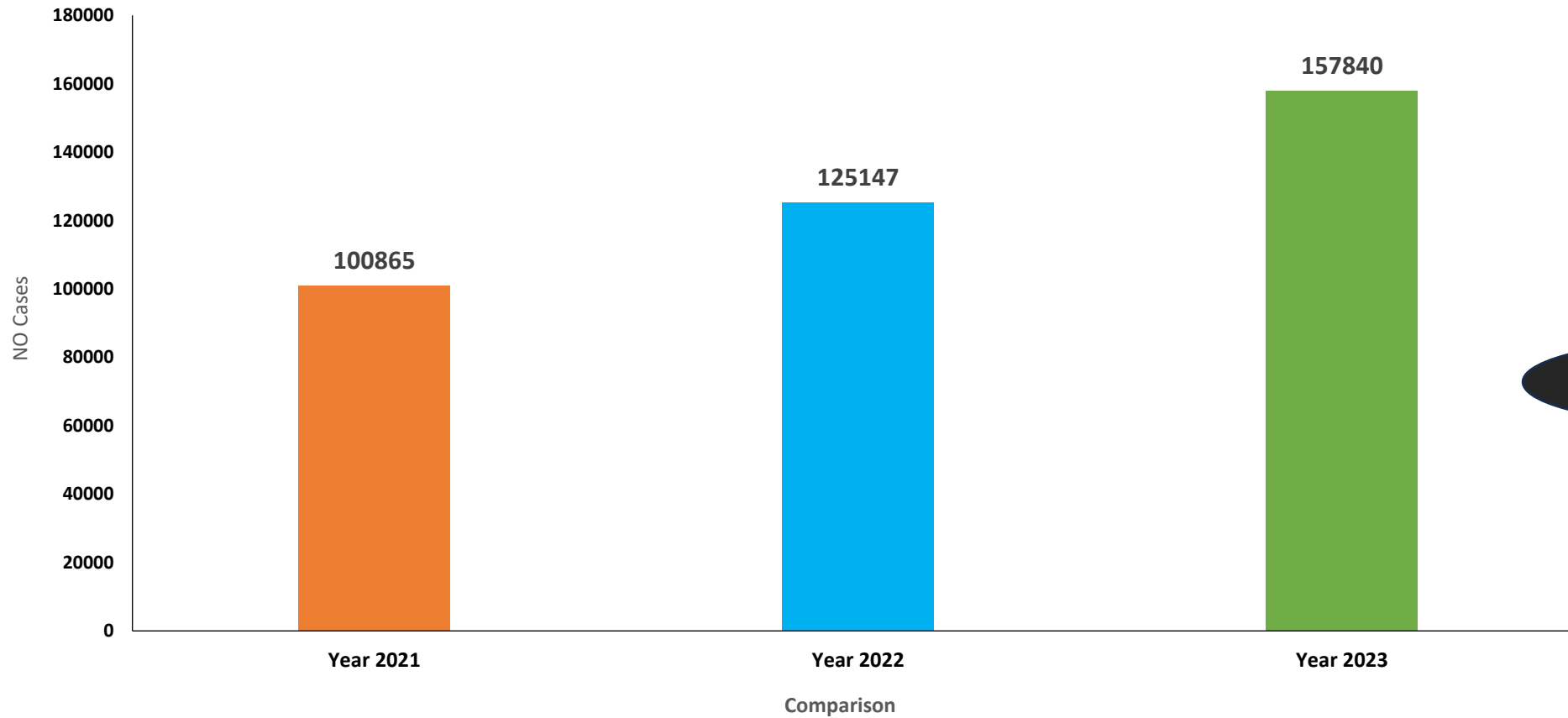

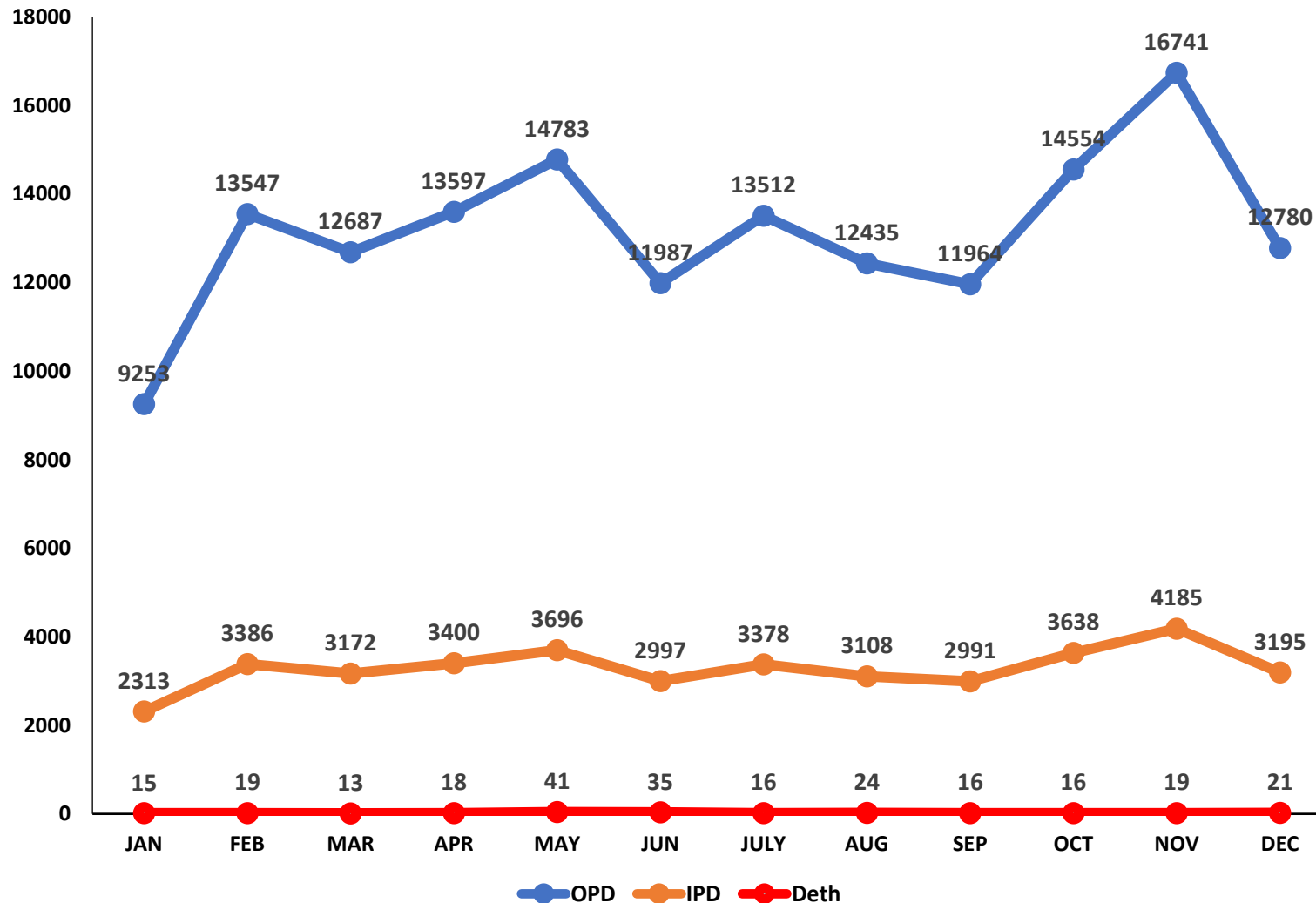

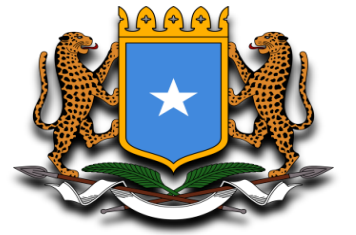
Annual Morbidity and Mortality Cases



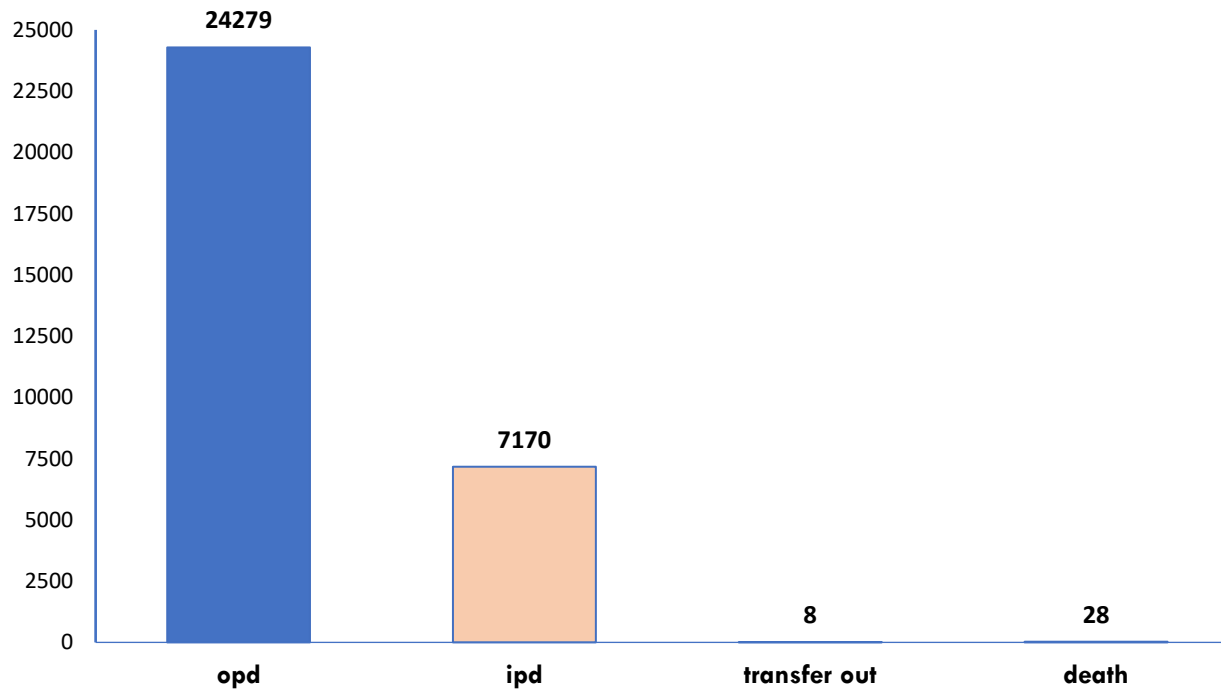

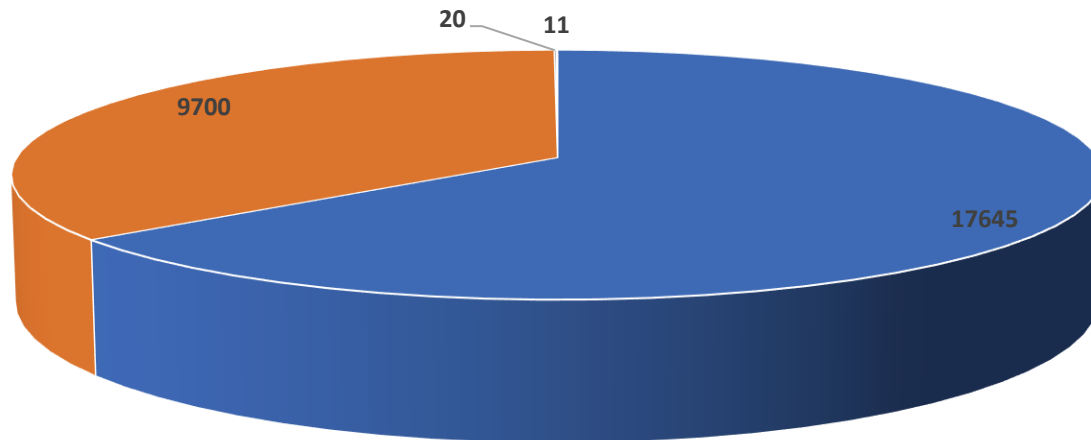

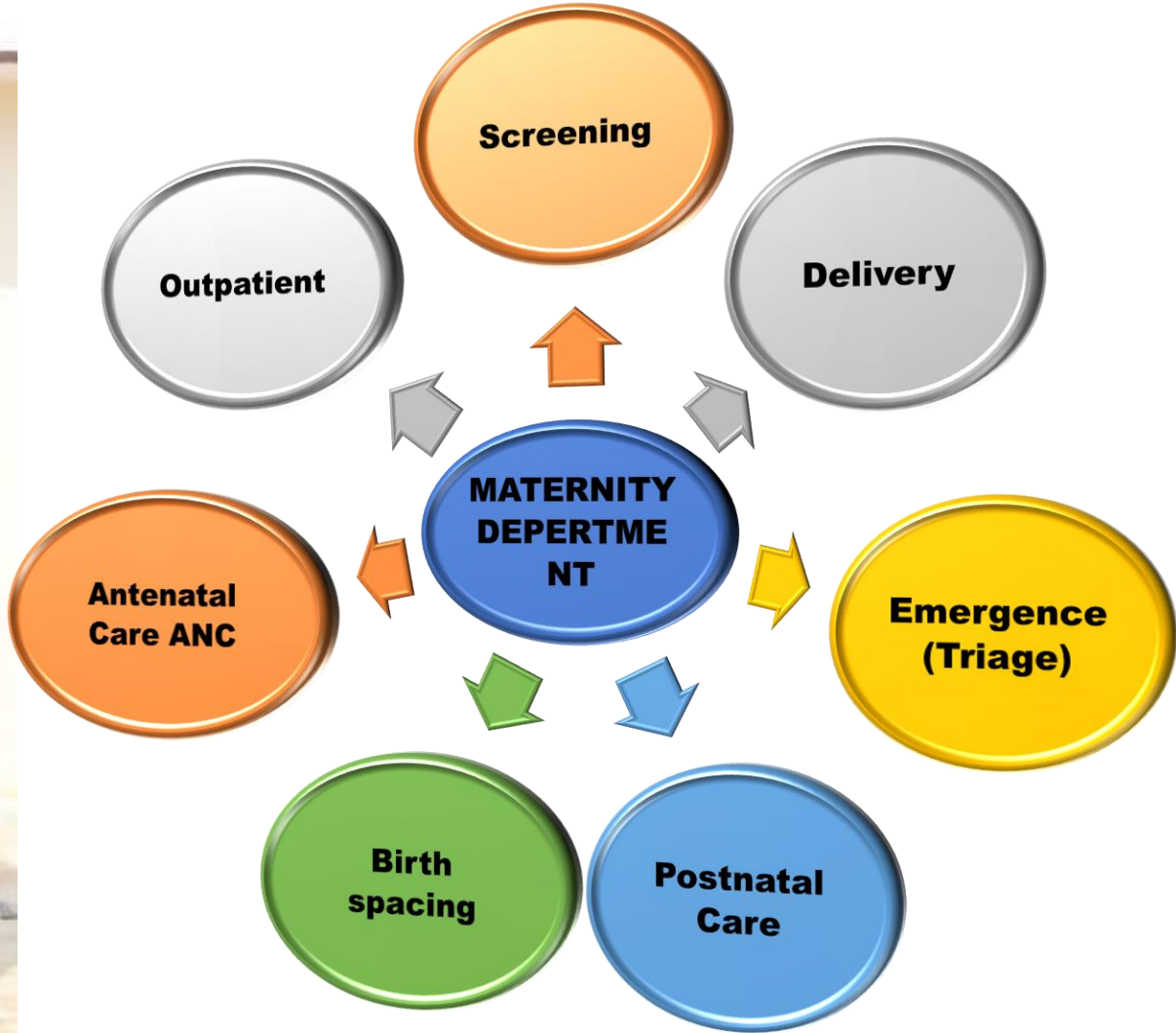

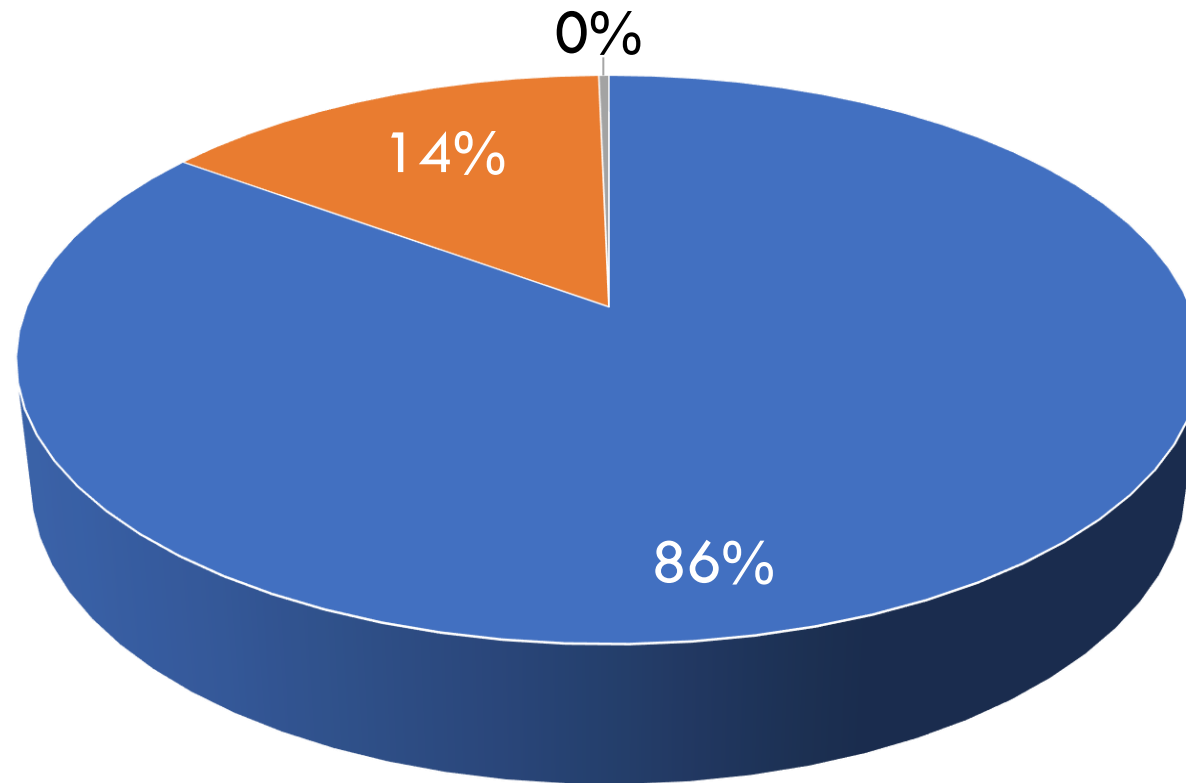

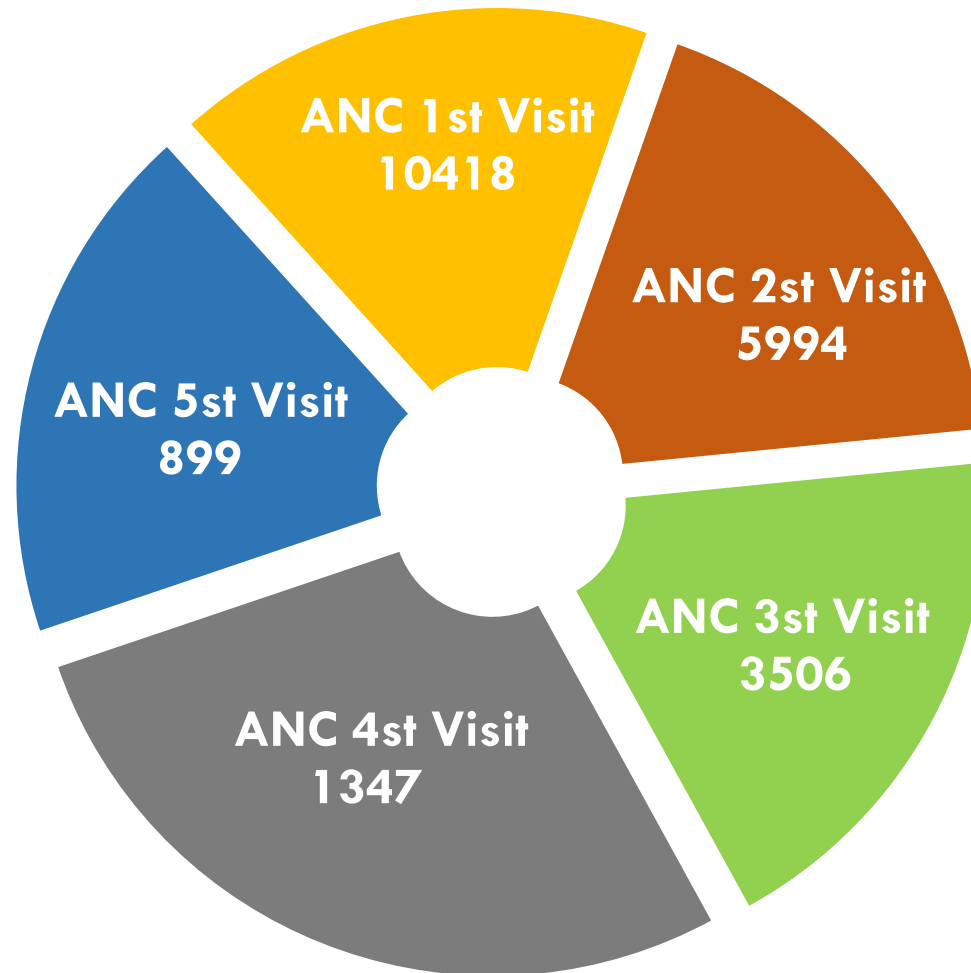

9910 as total but **8520** mothers were delivered normally, and **15** cases were delivered as assisted vaginal delivers, while **1375** cases were done CS.



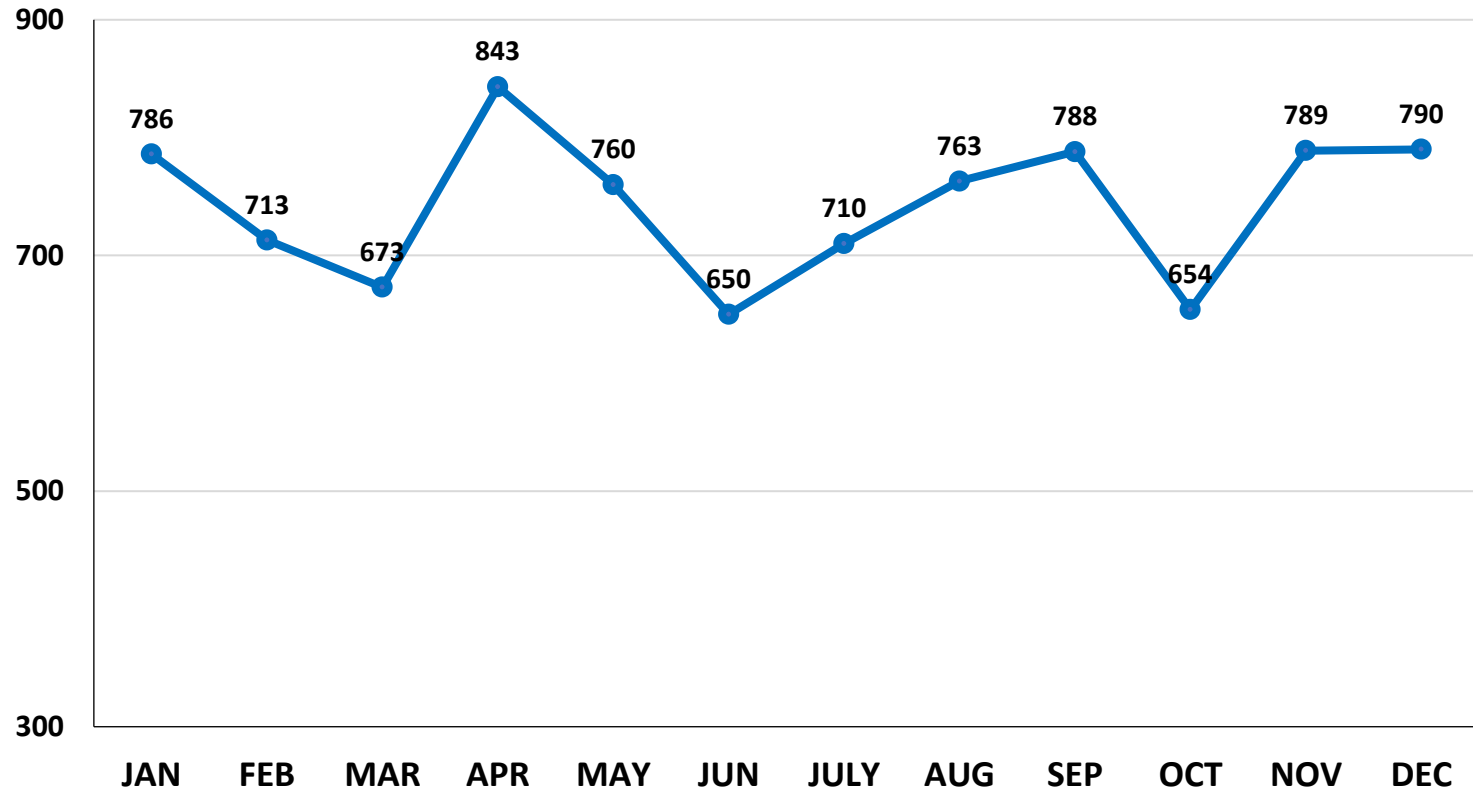

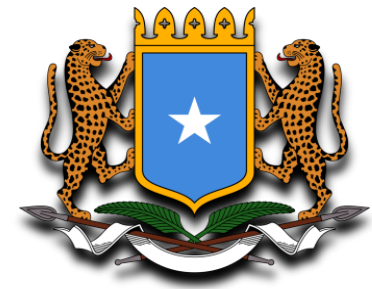

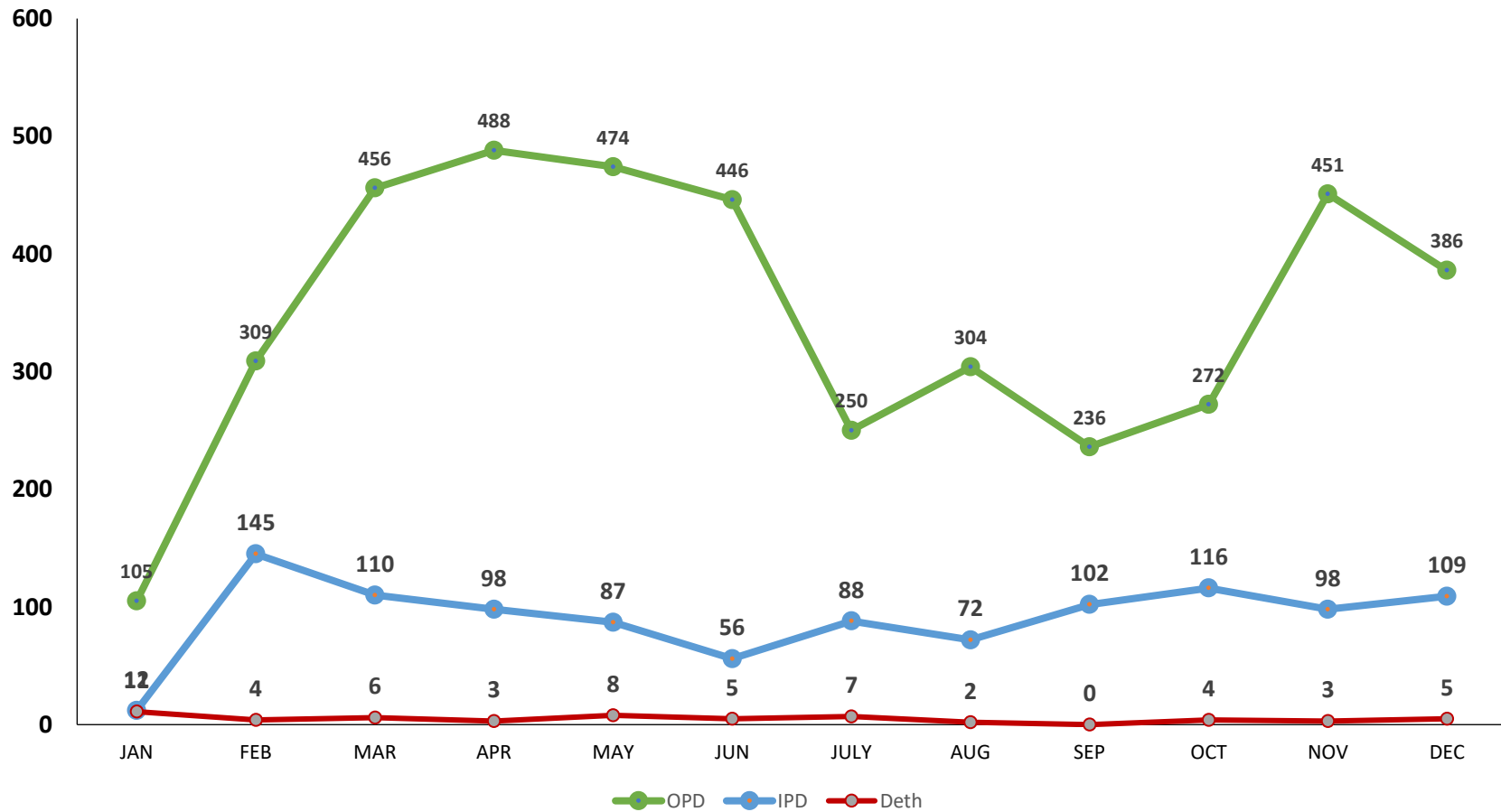

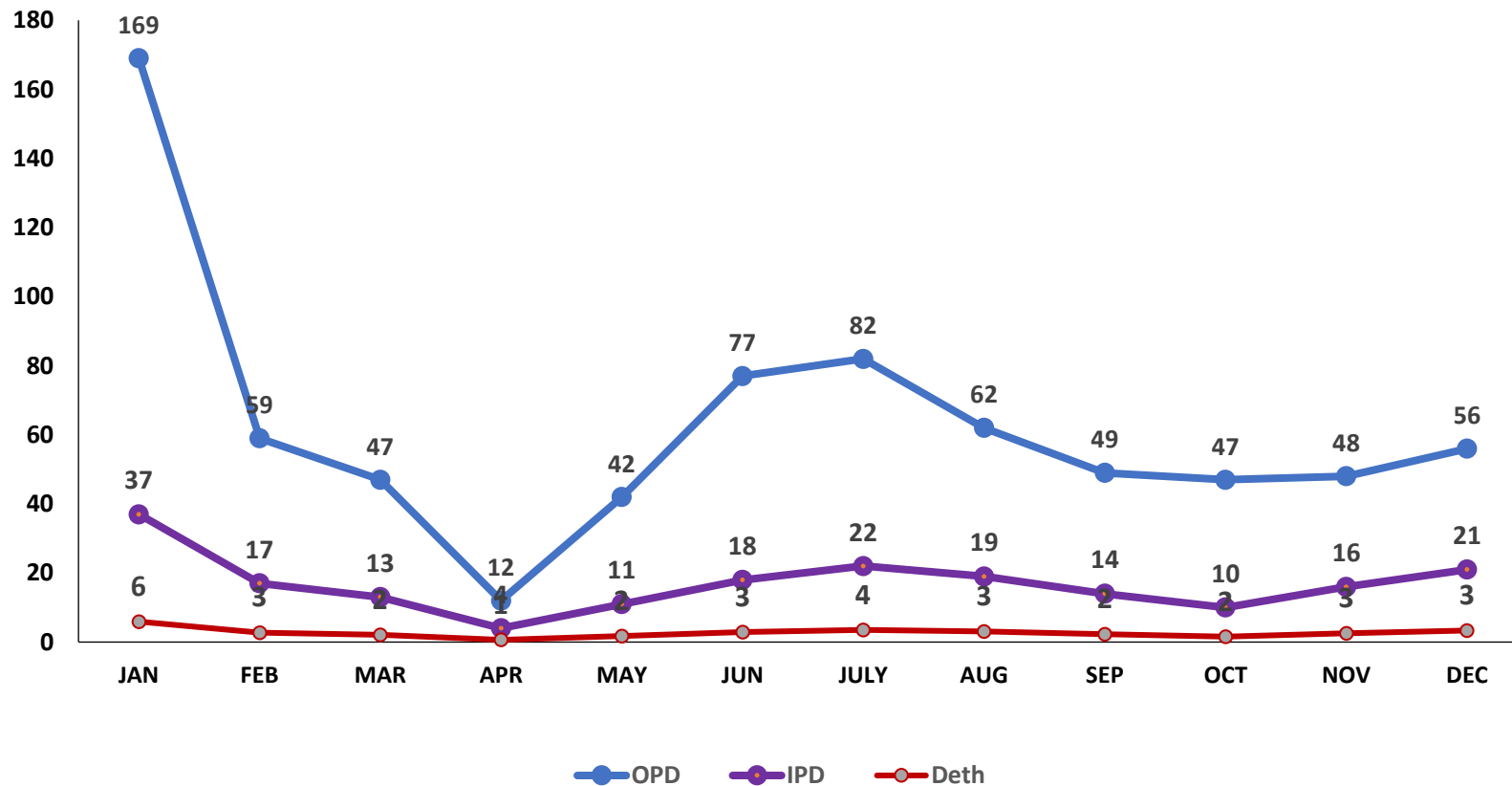


As a figure shows the total number of cases served in De-martino Hospitals due to Pneumonia was **4177** cases, **1093** cases were IPD.

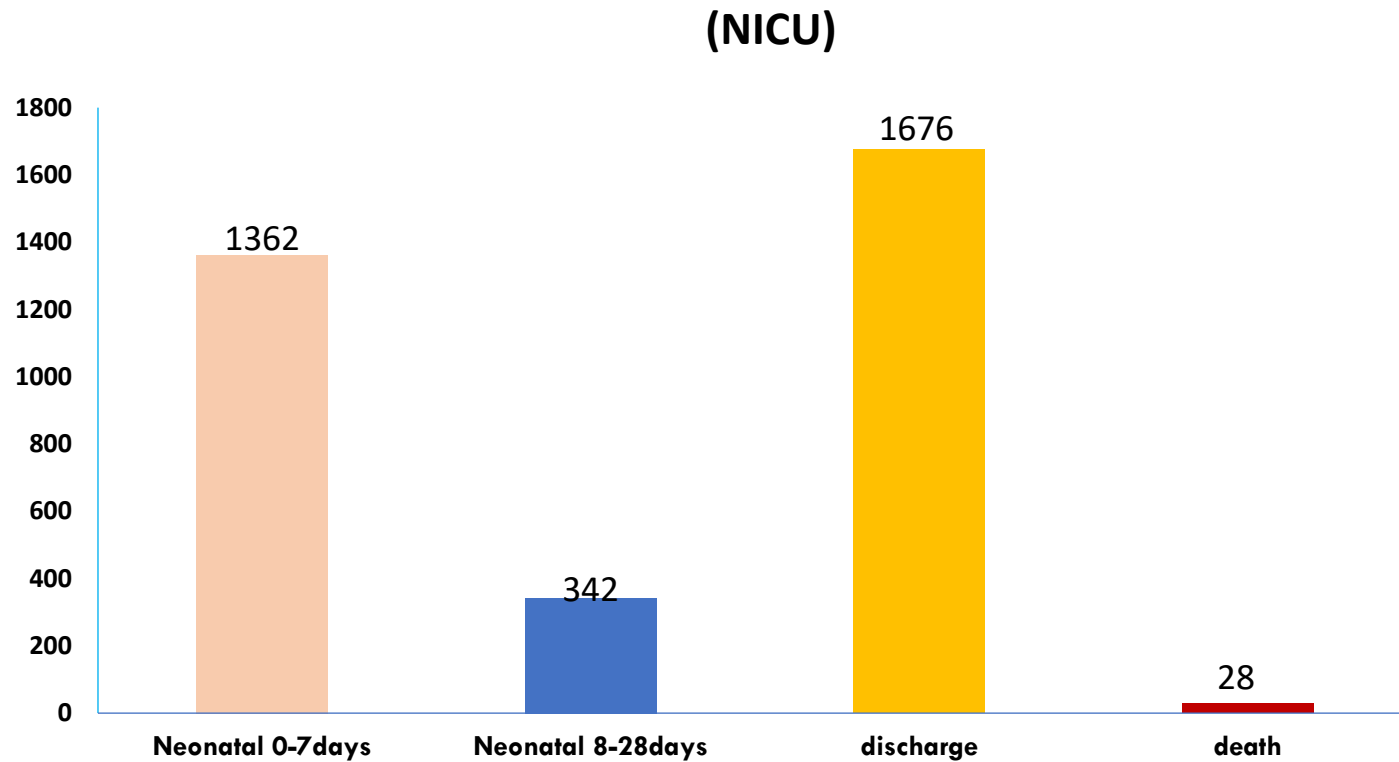
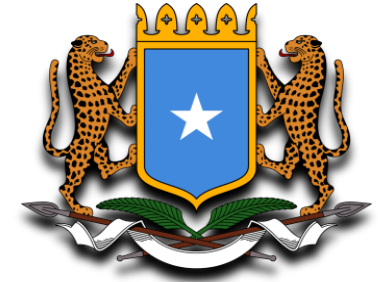


As a figure shows the total number of cases served in De-Martino Hospitals of diarrhea were **750** cases, **202** cases were IPD.

The total death of admitted cases was **32**.



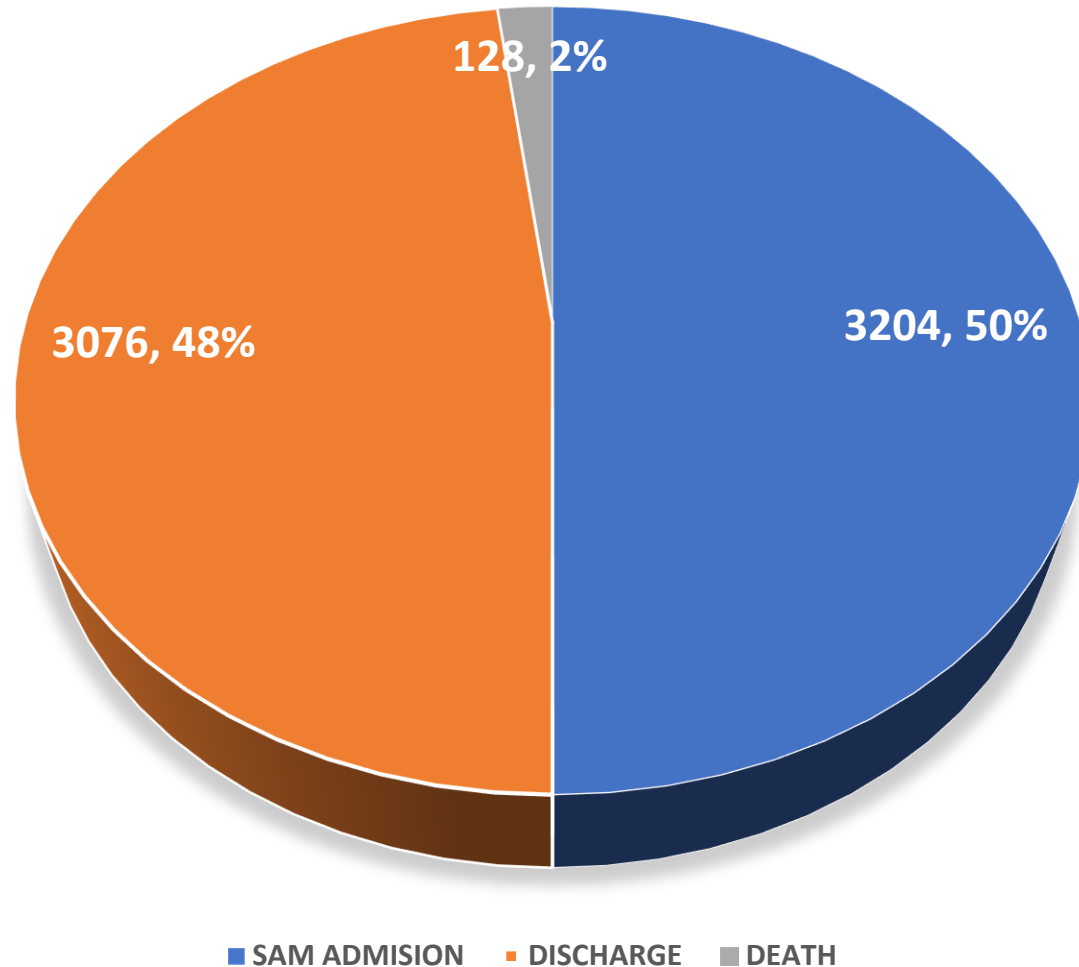
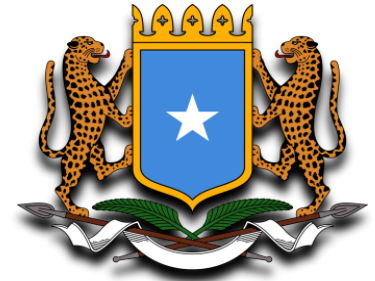
Neonatal intensive care unit (NICU)

SAM cases

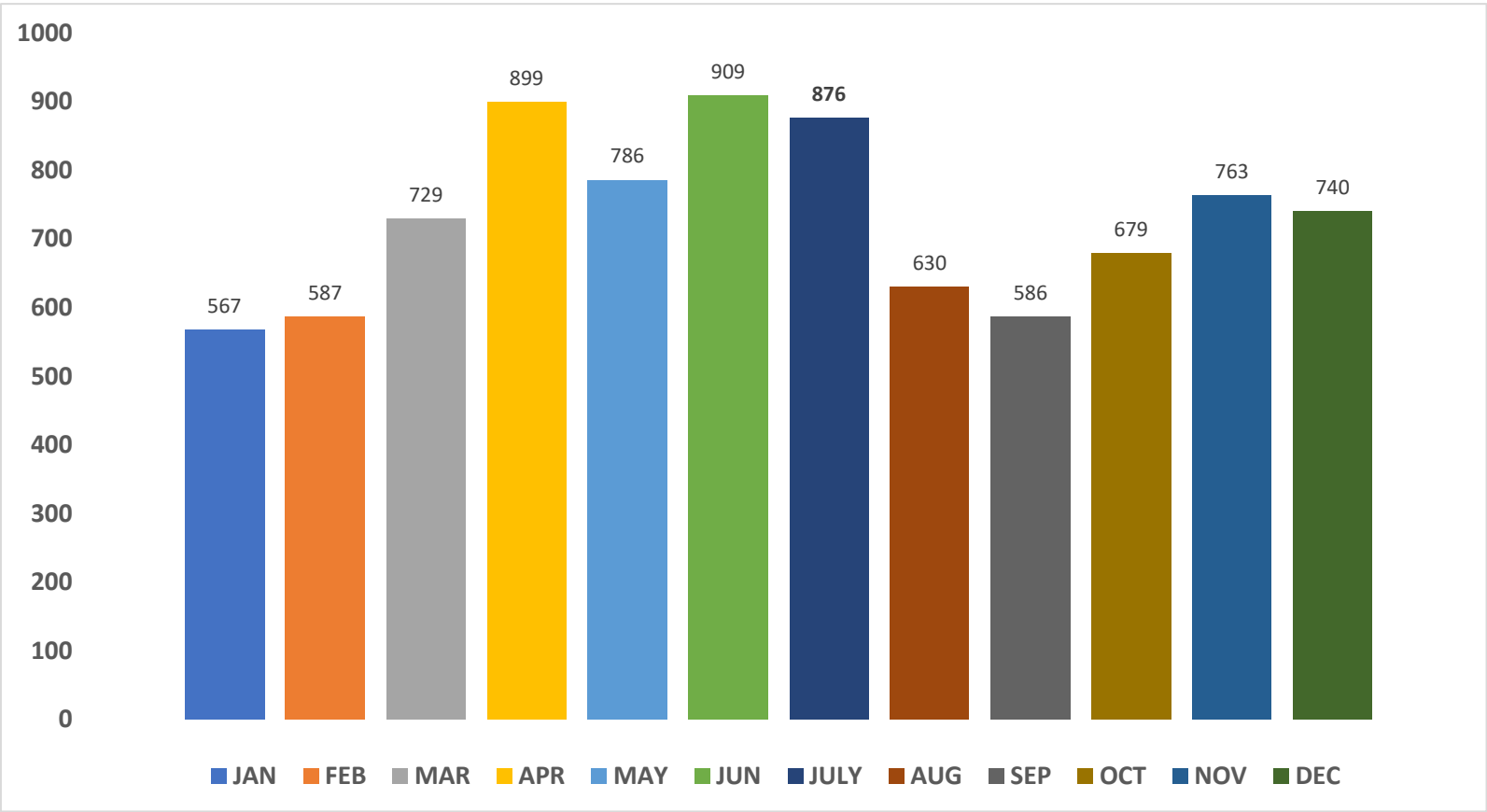


As a figure shows the total number of cases served in De-martino Hospitals of SAM **3204** were admitted, **3076** cases were discharged.

The total dearth of admitted cases was **128**.



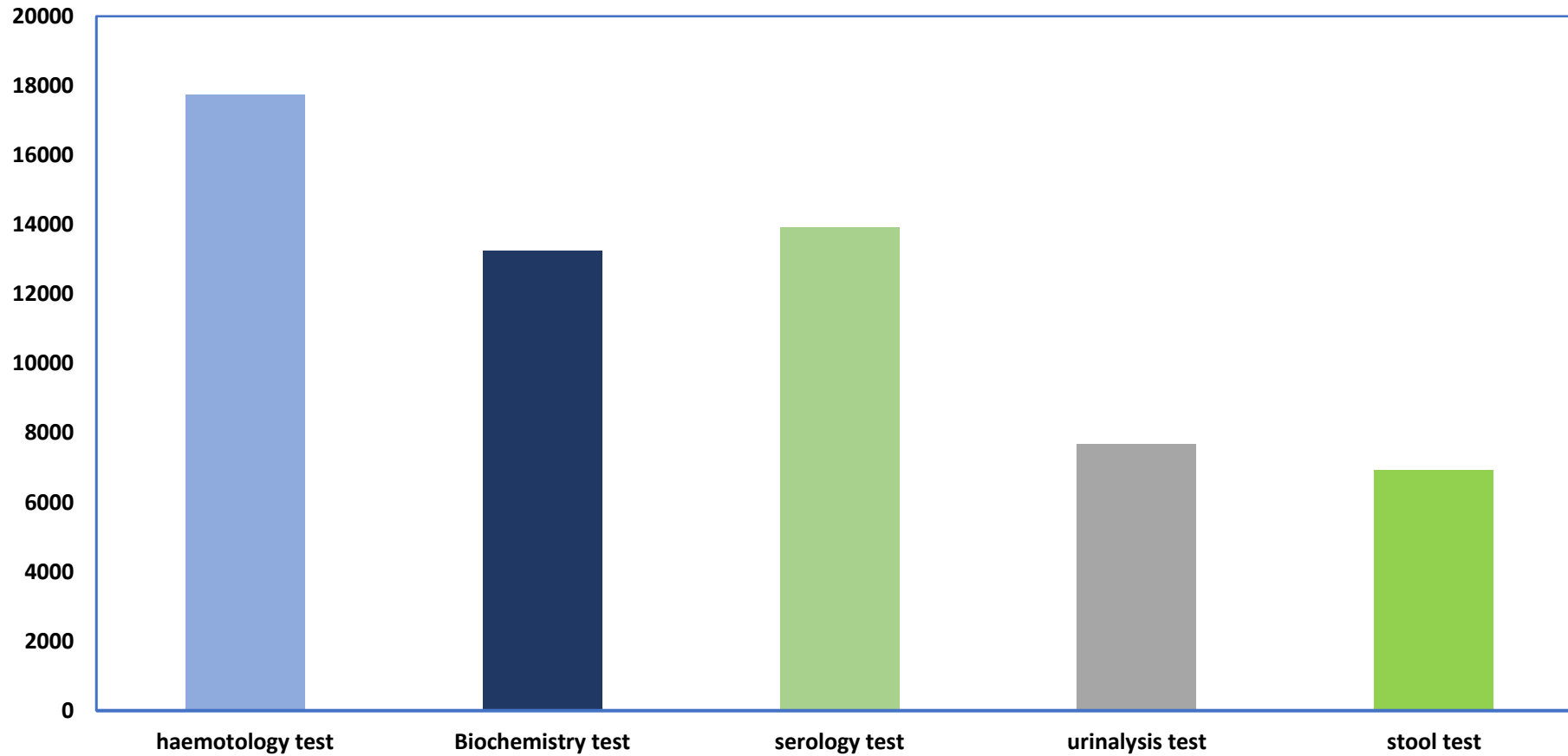

Total Number of X-ray service 8751

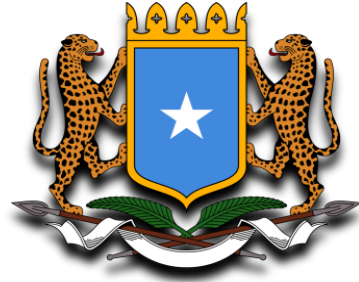

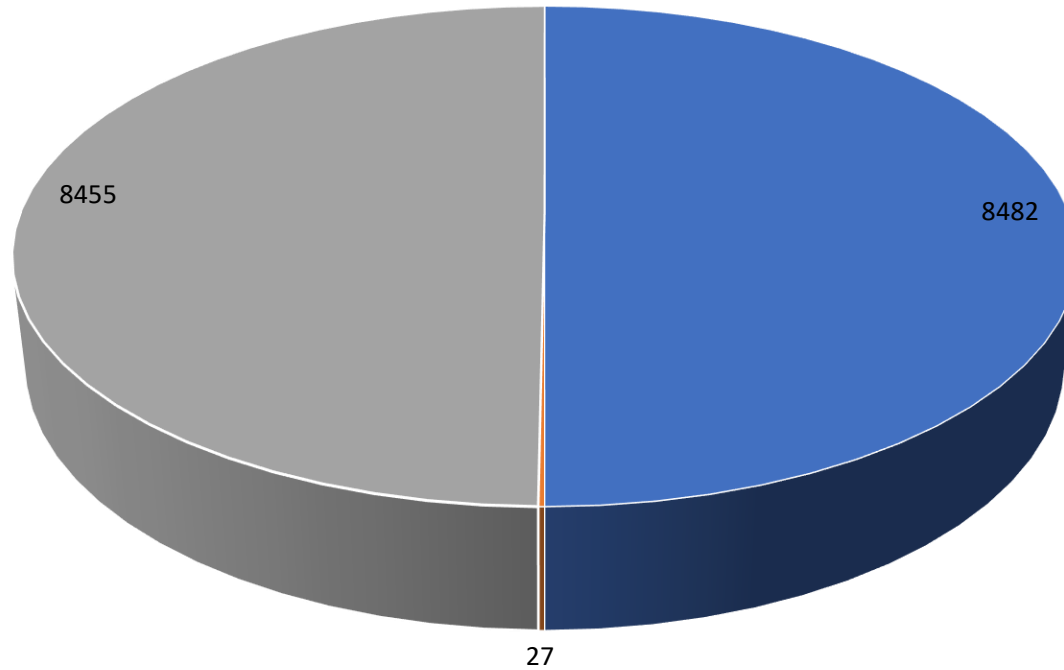

Challenges 2023



1: Less than 20% of the hospital staff are currently government employees and receive incentives from the Somali government while most of the hospital workers are project and program-based staff and when the project ends, they voluntarily work and sometimes they volunteer more than a year and wait for another project or program to receive their incentives

2: Supplies and operational resources are always challenging and the hospital operations and supplies are dependent on the donations from organizations

3: Limited Supply, Some Diagnostic Tools and Equipment

4: Staff Not yet included among civil servants

5: Lack of hospital residence program
