Services Utilization and Scope of Practice

De-Martino Public Hospital delivers a wide array of medical services designed to address the comprehensive healthcare needs of our patients. Over the past six months, our utilization statistics reflect the extensive and diverse care we provide:

- **Outpatient Services:** We have served 3,580 female and 2,310 male patients, demonstrating our broad reach and capacity.
- **Emergency and Day Care Services:** Managed 3,476 female and 4,963 male patients, reflecting our critical role in urgent and day care scenarios.
- **General Medicine:** Recorded 1,968 admissions, 1,901 discharges, 31 deaths, and 10 referrals, underscoring our focus on both acute and chronic care.
- **Surgical Trauma and Injuries:** Treated 1,463 admissions with 1,358 discharges, highlighting our proficiency in surgical interventions.
- **Maternity/Gynaecology:** Provided care for 1,457 admissions, ensuring safe deliveries and women's health services.
- **Intensive Care Unit (ICU):** Catered to patients requiring critical care with advanced life-support systems.
- **Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU):** Facilitated 464 admissions, supporting our youngest patients with specialized neonatal care.
- **Infectious Diseases:** Addressed 316 measles, 174 tuberculosis, and 210 hepatitis cases and 158 diphtheria cases emphasizing our commitment to managing infectious diseases.
- **Stabilization Center Services:** Managed a variety of non-communicable diseases, providing essential stabilization care.
- **Laboratory Services:** Conducted over 7,910 biochemistry tests and numerous other diagnostic tests, ensuring accurate diagnosis and treatment.
- **Immunization and Malaria Services:** Delivered extensive immunization coverage and malaria testing, crucial for preventive care.
- **Blood Bank Services:** Screened numerous donors, ensuring a safe and reliable blood supply.
- **Antenatal Care (ANC):** Provided comprehensive care with 4335 ANC visits, ensuring maternal and child health.
- **Medical Imaging:** Performed thousands of X-rays and ultrasounds, supporting accurate diagnostics.
- **Physiotherapy Services:** Assisted in patient rehabilitation, promoting recovery and well-being.
